Brevard C.A.R.E.S. (Coordination, Advocacy, Resources, Education and Support) is a family-centered, strength-based, and community-driven model for child abuse prevention and family preservation. The program's unique "Wraparound" approach and Family Team Conferencing offers services and support to families experiencing stressors that could lead to abuse, neglect or abandonment.

WHAT IS PREVENTION?

A majority of the families referred to the Brevard C.A.R.E.S. program are experiencing some type of family stress and/or isolation. Some have been referred to the program by Child Protective Investigators after an investigation of reported abuse or neglect, while others are referred by family, friends, clergy, teachers or others concerned about the family's safety. Because these families chose to enter Brevard C.A.R.E.S. their children remain safe and healthy, and can stay in their homes, schools and communities. They find the support they need, and now these families have been diverted from a path that may lead to neglect and abuse.



In the spirit of the popular belief, "It takes a village to raise a child," Wraparound is a model that supports and encourages families toward their goals of safety and stability with the assistance of the people who are involved in their lives. It consists of formal and informal supports that assist the family in reaching their goals.

FAMILY TEAM CONFERENCING

A key component of our Brevard C.A.R.E.S. program is the concept of Family Team Conferencing, providing families with natural supports that help them to develop and implement plans to ensure their stability and the health and welfare of their children.

Employing Wraparound and Family Team Conferencing models, this family-centered, strength-based program gives families voice and choice in determining their goals, the makeup of their support team, and the best courses of action to help them through their individual situation.

Families receive the same services available to those in the formal dependency system without having to enter it, saving untold millions of dollars that are then reinvested into our system of care to provide additional services and capacity. The average monthly cost of court-ordered out-of-home care for one child in Brevard is approximately \$2,500; serving a child in Brevard CARES costs only about \$250 per month!

SUCCESS IN KEEPING CHILDREN SAFE AND FAMILIES TOGETHER

The first referral to the Brevard C.A.R.E.S. program was on July 27, 2005. We served two children that month and demand has steadily increased.

Since then, Brevard CARES has helped to keep over 12,000 children and their families from entering the formal dependency system. And, as a result of removing the stigma once attached to seeking assistance an increasing number of families are "self-referring" in that they are seeking assistance themselves before a situation at home becomes a crisis.

"THE RESULTS"

Thousands of children and families are remaining safely in their homes, free from abuse and neglect and working to improve their daily lives; and the data proves it. 100% of families who successfully completed the Brevard C.A.R.E.S. program do not have a verified report of maltreatment at the six and twelve-month follow up.

That's the reason other counties in Florida and child care agencies across the nation are eager to replicate what we've achieved.
